At her most recent start Last Waltz ran a game second at Sandown on May 7 attempting to again lead throughout and was only collared in the last 100 metres to go under three quarters of a length. Important race for her as she has now earned a metropolitan placing which obviously increases her value as a brood mare which excites some members of the syndicate who are keen to breed with her at the end of her racing career. Prior to her Sandown run she dominated a weak Pakenham Class 4 to lead all the way to win by 5 lengths and pick up a nice \$6,500

cheque for connections. This mare has been placed beautifully by her trainer Mick Price and has now had 15 starts for 5 wins, 3 seconds and 1 third for \$49,675 in stakes.

In other stable news our rising two year olds are all progressing well and currently our Choisir colt and our Royal Academy filly are both in with John Stocker at Glenfern Park and are doing well while our Bel Esprit filly has only just commenced with John as I am writing this newsletter. She will be with him for a further 4 weeks of education before again having a short break. All three horses broke in well and had good temperaments and were sensible in their initial breakings which is all that anyone wishes to hear at this early stage.



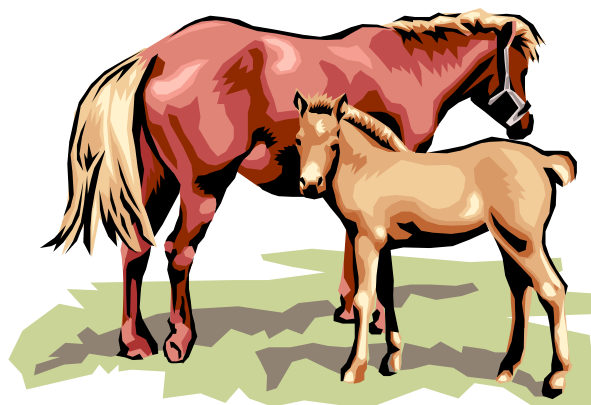
