## Royal Academy Colt For Syndication — Share Price \$4750

A recent addition to the stable an outstanding colt by champion sire Royal Academy which was purchased for \$60,000 at the Melbourne Premier Sale is now underway and members are well and truly encouraged to get involved. The colt question is a half-brother to a stake's place getter and comes from an outstanding family that boasts multiple Group 1 performers that include Mnemosyne (winner of \$1,371,975 in stakes) via victories in the STC Queen of the Turf Stakes and MRC 1000 Guineas (both that Group 1 level), Full on Aces winner of the STC Golden Slipper — Group 1, Drawn winner of VATC Caulfield Guineas — Group 1, STC Rosehill Guineas — Group 1 and AJC All-Aged Stakes — Group 1 and other Group 2 and black type performers in Draw Card, Ulfah, Jumpin Jive, Special Draw, Wise Draw, Top of the Pack, Better Draw, My Juliet, Perfect Draw etc — the list just goes on and on.

The colt's dam is Neidin (x Kenmare) who as a brood mare sire has sired the dams of 571 individual winners of over \$55.3 million including Virage de Fortune, Helene Pillaging, Faith Hill, Palia, Written Tycoon, Mardi's Magic, Pinezero, Dane Beltar, Any Rhythm, Typhoon Billie, Fullazz etc.

He is a lovely loose walking athletic colt that reminds us very much of La Bella Dame, in fact although slightly bigger he could be considered the male version of this filly who a number of our syndicate members enjoyed Group success with a few years ago. For

those members that have not viewed the video of this colt as yet on our web site [www.unitedsyndications.com.au](http://www.unitedsyndications.com.au) please do and judge for yourselves as the likeness in Mick and my opinions is frightening.

Such is our enthusiasm on this colt that in order to involve as many of our current syndicate members as possible I am putting together two shares made up of those members wanting to take a smaller piece of a share — be that a half, a quarter, third or even a tenth of a share starting at \$475.
