Look for him to be starting to make significant improvement over the ensuing weeks!

Super Choi — our Choisir 3YO is also progressing well and is set to make his racetrack debut at Sale on Thursday, January 24 in a 1400m maiden. This guy has made improvement at each of his preparations and surprisingly is a Choisir that seems to be looking for distance.

Other horses that will also be hitting the tracks in the upcoming weeks include Princess Carolina who has arrived into Mick's stables and Colbert.

Princess Carolina had a terrific spell and pre-trainer Sean Mott has commented a couple of times how well she looks and the excellent condition and muscle that she now carries. This will be the best prep to date and we will endeavor to place her to the best of our abilities in order to earn maximum prize money for her band of

enthusiastic owners.

Colbert has also pleased since being gelded and will be the next to enter Mick's shortly. This son of Royal Academy had an excellent prep when last at Mick's culminating in two trials but fell away physically towards the end due to inexperience and immaturity. A lot more settled this time in, it will be interesting to see how he copes with stable life when next given the chance.

Our other Royal Academy filly, **Royal Charades** has recently been spelled due to jarring up on the hard tracks that were presented to us over the Spring Carnival. Drawing the wrong side of the track and being knocked several times in the run her effort to finish only 2.9 lengths away in a Listed race on Oaks Day was full of merit and is a definite city horse. She will resume over the winter months in conditions that should suit admirably as the breed normally relish soft conditions.

Our New Zealand Pentire stayer comes over to Australia shortly and will go immediately up to John Ledger at Wangaratta to continue on with his education. Reports from New Zealand indicate that he is a very forward Pentire with an excellent temperament. With our 2008 Staying Syndicate all but completed Pentire's have the record on the board and we will be actively seeking out their stock when we head abroad next week.

Inglis on the Front Foot

A total of \$2.5 million will be on offer with over 20 races or bonuses available to win.
