From the Stable

Some promising information from the breakers, some frustrating and disappointing performances and some retirements (one sad one in particular) all highlight an eventful 3 months for our owners. Early breaker information is always useful and sometimes exciting and this year has been no different. Our Magic Millions **SO YOU THINK/DATABLE** filly has shown a fantastic attitude since day one and right now is concluding her first real prep after being broken in and has pleased all throughout. Is starting to roll up a last furlong and is doing that on her ear according to Brad Ledger. She is a scopey filly who covers the ground well and has a lovely action about her. Whilst you do not expect a So You Think to be prominent in the early 2YO races, attitude is 90% of it as an early horse and she has been faultless throughout. Our **RUSSIAN REVOLUTION/PEPPERMINT PATTY** colt has broken in to outstanding reports and did everything like he had done it 100 times before so this guy has quite a wrap about him. He is currently spelling and will continue to do so for about another 2-3 weeks before resuming pre-training. This guy looks a likely early type and would be expected to head on down to Caulfield at some point during his next prep for a look see and for Mick and Michael Kent to be assessing him accurately as to whether he is indeed an early 2YO type. The Russian Revolutions really impressed as early types having looked at most of them at the sales this year and it wouldn't be any surprise at all to see them figure prominently at the races prior to Xmas!

Our **CAPITALIST/LOVEYAMADLY** filly and our **FIGHTING SUN/LIBERTY MADE** filly worked through their first preps together after breaking and both pleased with their attitudes and willingness to learn. They were taken out on to the track in groups bowling along in front and from behind and were taken through the barriers without issue. They are now currently spelling and will continue to do so for about another 4 weeks before resuming work with the Ledgers and most likely will be heading on down to Caulfield for a look see next time around .

There were some frustrating preps where nothing seemed to go right and **IMMORTAL LOVE** was right up there regarding the frustrating factor. Promising signs early with a very good 6th first up at Caulfield in April which was followed up with an excellent 4th beaten 1.7 lengths at Flemington second up, then resulted in 3 disappointing runs over the recent QLD Carnival. A messy campaign where nothing seemed to go right, **IMMORTAL LOVE** was brought back to Caulfield and is expected to be running over 1400 metres at Flemington on Saturday 17th July. **IMMORTAL LOVE** thrived up at Eagle Farm whilst he was there and has returned in super order. Mick is keen to continue on with his campaign right now and is expected to bounce back coming back from **GROUP** and **LISTED** company. He is a nice horse as his record of 9 starts for 3 wins and \$176,713 suggests and is definitely a horse to be followed when he returns to the track in the next few weeks!

Two horses that have showed much promise that are similar to **IMMORTAL LOVE** but again had frustrating preps include both **SCORPIUS** and **ZENDE**. **SCORPIUS**, is a horse that we indeed had high hopes for yet frustratingly has just won the 2 races for a horse of his ability. Works the track down at home yet can't seem to reproduce that ability come race day, however Mick and Michael Kent are treating him as a challenge and are keen to progress on with him after this upcoming spell. Having him fresh and around the 1200 metre mark and ridden quiet seems to be the key as his run two starts back was very good at Pakenham when running second. Failing at his next start due to an EIPH issue when running a short price favourite, **SCORPIUS** is now currently spelling but Mick is confident he has him worked out and we look forward to see him returning to the winners stall next time around. He is a sound horse and we are very hopeful that he will be improving his current race record of 19 starts for 2 wins, 4 seconds and a third for \$117,275. The same can also be said about **ZENDE** who was also a most promising 3YO. A relatively lightly raced 4YO who has had just the 13 runs for 2 wins, 2 seconds and 2 thirds for \$96,185 in stakes, after trialling up well from Mick's

Warrnambool base and two fair runs early on at Warrnambool and Cranbourne, **ZENDE** didn't go on with it at his subsequent runs. The thought was that he simply didn't back up into his \$60,000 mile final at Cranbourne late May which he qualified for the week previous and was pretty flat after that so much so that he was spelled after his following run at Ballarat. It is pretty clear to Mick and Michael that this horse races well fresh and will be kept to 1200 metres and fresh next prep in between runs. **ZENDE** is a talented galloper and Mick and Michael feel confident that he will bounce back as he went to the paddock sound and well.

One horse that has had a pleasing return to the track recently after a long break was our 3YO filly **JOURNALESE**. Coming off just on a 1 year absence from the track due to POD disease which we treated conservatively with a 6 month spell (mandatory for this type of issue), **JOURNALESE** did all of her pre training and galloping work down at Warrnambool and much credit also should be given to Andrew Bobbin at Stawell for the work that he did with her early on. That work along with the heavy sand work/beach training that Matthew Williams did with this filly enabled her to get a great fitness base without the usual concussion of a track program. That work almost paid off first up when she was beaten by the narrowest of margins

first up at Echuca. Coming off two nice trials **JOURNALESE** missed the start and didn't have the best of luck, getting much further back than anticipated on a Heavy 10 rated track that was conducive to settling in the first few as the track pattern for the day proved. Coming from 5th at the turn, jockey Liam Riordan extracted **JOURNALESE** to the centre of the track and having balanced up came with a withering run only to just fail on the line. It was a very promising return to the track and having pulled up well will most likely head towards a lovely \$35,000 1300 metre race for fillies at Bendigo on July 15 which is a most suitable race. A filly who shows good ability and tries hard, **JOURNALESE** is a horse that should be followed and would be expected to run very well as the increase in distance to 1300 metres looks ideal!

Another horse that had a pleasing debut and we look forward very much to her return to the track is promising filly **BRING ME FLOWERS** who was desperately unlucky at her very first run at Werribee back in April. Missing the start and spat out the back settling last which is normally poison for Werribee, **BRING ME FLOWERS** worked through the field along the fence and held up just prior to the turn when trying to improve she was forced to change course on straightening and when jockey Zac Spain was poised to get a run in between runners half way down the straight that run

closed and Zac was forced to check off heels. To be beaten only 2.9 lengths she was clearly the run of the race and looks to have a very promising future. Popped away after that run she is rated a Metropolitan standard filly by the stable and has really grown and blossomed during her most recent spell. She has just resumed pre training with John Ledger at Wangaratta and will be down at Caulfield in the next few weeks. Look out for her when she resumes racing as this filly looks a lovely filly in the making and is certainly destined for better things once she gets into her 3YO career and as her racing evolves!

On a sad note, one of our all time favourites in **FIGHTING HARADA** has been officially retired after sustaining an injury out of his last run at Warrnambool in May when running 3rd. A horse who has shown outstanding ability all through his career but unfortunately was a horse that was always injury prone due to his outstandingly large physique, **FIGHTING HARADA** over came many set backs and had

amazing resilience but after his most recent injury which was not life threatening but another long rehab necessary, it was felt that he would be better placed off the track to recover and to enjoy his life. This has now seen him placed with one of Australia's top show riders in Ali Berwick- a successful and proven rider in the best of company who has agreed to rehab **FIGHTING HARADA** over the next year and then to prepare him for the next stages of his life. This will no doubt be a future success story as **FIGHTING HARADA** has all the credentials and looks necessary to be successful as is her rider who is already proven at the highest level! We pay homage to **FIGHTING HARADA** and follow his life after racing with great interest. **FIGHTING HARADA** had a most successful career having had 12 starts for 5 wins, 2 seconds and 2 thirds for \$209,340 in stakes and certainly did his wonderful Syndicate proud on the track and will no doubt continue to do so off the track in the years ahead!

All three of these mares have the credentials to be most commercial Broodmares for their respective Syndicates and have every indication that they can produce quality gallopers that our Broodmares of the past have delivered with horses of the quality of **DAMSEFLY**, **LE BON SIR**, **ROYAL SNITZEL**, **FIGHTING HARADA** and **IMMORTAL LOVE**- all quality and **STAKES** performed. By breeding with our mares it gives the opportunity to be breeding/racing horses that we would not normally be able to purchase at the sales as they would simply be too expensive and also allows us to be selling those that we think appropriate and to achieve a result in the ring which is akin to be winning a **GROUP** race on the track!

MISS DAMITA is a three quarter blood sister to **GROUP 1** VRC Derby winner **KIBBUTZ** who had a most successful racing career having had 28 starts for 5 wins, 4 seconds and 5 thirds for \$139,905 in stakes. **BELLA AMORE** is a **FULL**

sister to our **GROUP 3** Winning 3YO **IMMORTAL LOVE** hailing from the great Beauty World family and was successful at Metropolitan level, City placed at Flemington and is by the super stallion **SNITZEL** earning \$85,065 on the track and **UNDOUBTEDLY SO** is a half sister to our three time **GROUP 3** placed **ROYAL SNITZEL** and is by one of Australia's most prolific sires in **NOT A SINGLE DOUBT**. All three of these mares are at most value to their respective syndicates at stud and we look forward to success with their progeny in the years ahead both on the track and in the sales ring!
