He seems to be at his best when ridden a touch quiet and left to be produced late in the straight as he was two starts ago on the Pakenham Synthetic when he was ridden that way only to narrowly fail. **SCORPIUS** is definitely running out of chances however he simply can't be faulted in the way he has come up this prep but as they say the proof will be in the pudding. He is a lovely sound gelding so there will be few excuses if he can't get the job done in the first few runs this time around!

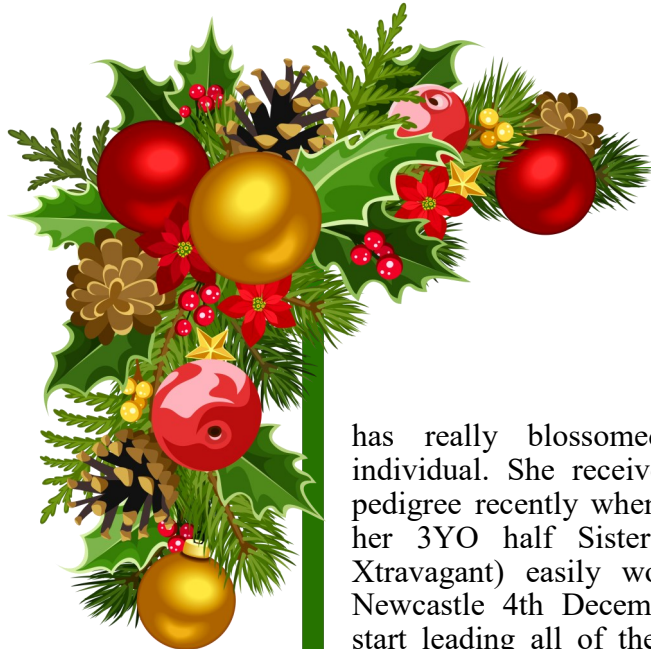
With numbers currently down due to injuries/retirements to **FIGHTING HARADA**, **ZENDE**, **JOURNALESE** and **IMMORTAL LOVE**, the retirements to stud of **MISS DAMITA**, **UNDOUBTEDLY SO** and **BELLA AMORE** and a couple that we have moved on all happening virtually at the same time, we are looking more to the future right now to build back our stocks at the sales, and with our 2YO'S who are now starting to arrive down at Cranbourne. All of them are doing well and we have had no issues with anyone of them to date with **I'MLOVIN'YA** and **LUSCIOUS** the first to show their beautiful faces down at Cranbourne. These two have just arrived and have done an even time session and a 600/200 session Saturday but are ticking the boxes with what they have done to date. Both horses have settled into their new surroundings without issue and Mick and Michael Kent will take them both through for as long as they think it safe to do so. Both **I'MLOVIN'YA** and **LUSCIOUS** have outstanding temperaments which from history will take them a fair way through to hopefully the trial stage as being stressed is the least of their problems.

Our 2021 purchases from this year **SO DATABLE** (Gold Coast Magic Millions) and **RUSSIAN MINT** (Adelaide Magic Millions) have resumed pre training and both are expected down to Cranbourne in the coming weeks. **SO DATABLE** is a lovely **SO YOU THINK** filly who

has really blossomed into a lovely individual. She received a boost to her pedigree recently when the first foal and her 3YO half Sister RITA MAY (x Xtravagant) easily won her maiden at Newcastle 4th December at her second start leading all of the way and looks a progressive type. **SO DATABLE** has been held back a touch due to maturity/growth spurts and a Spring spell was considered most beneficial and to let nature take its course rather than being pushed. With the bulk of her growing now behind her, she will have a look at Cranbourne this time around and again her kind nature and willingness to learn will take her a long way to the trials when she comes down. **RUSSIAN MINT** on the other hand has a fair bit of “Spunk” and enthusiasm about him and was full of beans when he came down to Caulfield last prep. Only shin soreness prevented him from trialling last time around so he will go very close to trialling this time and although a bit coltish, reports from Wangaratta suggest that he seems to have come back a more settled horse this time around. From what Mick and Michael Kent know and reported previously about him, he has a turn of foot which hopefully we can harness. **RUSSIAN MINT** is a stunning individual who we all hope can run to his looks!

Food for Thought

When one looks at foaling dates at next year's yearling sales it should be presented as an opportunity rather than to bypass those yearlings that foal late. There is a serious misconception that late foals are backward and therefore success on the track can be limited early, however personally I look at it as an opportunity to buy and normally, you get a discount on the respective horse at the sale that is born from late October onwards. Yes they look a little bit more immature to the eye, however the bottom line is that it doesn't matter when they are born, as they will mature quick enough to do it if they are ready. The commercial imperative to get early covers and early foals are understandable given that statistics indicate those foals will sell for more through the ring, but as a buyer, it is something I am happy to work against. G3 Gimcrack S. winner **Coolangatta** (Written Tycoon), purchased through this year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale for \$280,000 from the draft of Milburn Creek, is an October 23 foal and collected her first stakes win at Randwick in early October, still short of her official second birthday. The Everest winner **Nature Strip** (Nicconi) shares a November 16 foaling date with **Anamoe**, while the likes of **Probabeel** (NZ) (Savabeel), **Think It Over** (NZ), **Duais** (Shamus Award), **Nettoyer** (Sebring) and **Celebrity Queen** (Redoute's Choice), **Willowy** (Kermadec), **Colette** (Hallowed Crown) and **Graceful Girl** (Nicconi) are all recent Group 1-winning November foals. With probably the most famous of the November GROUP 1 winners in So You Think (foaling date Nov 10) it makes a serious case for prospective buyers to take the foaling date out of the equation when assessing future yearlings after assessing the quality of those GROUP 1 winners!!

It certainly has been a rewarding Spring for all of our mares and we also two lovely foals on the ground by **MAGNUS** and **SO YOU THINK** which gives us plenty of optimism for the future. Our **MAGNUS/LIBERTY MADE** colt foal is a ripper and certainly has more bone and scope than **LIBERTY MADE'S** previous two foals, one of which is heading to Melbourne Premier for sale next year. That Yearling is a lovely medium athletic style of colt by **TORONADO** who is currently riding the crest of a wave with winners and is in the top 20 by winners and top 10 by Prize money on the General Sires tables. He has had an outstanding year to date and has already sired 4 Stakes winners in Masked Crusader, Rainbiel, Still A Star and the brilliant GROUP 2 WA Guineas winner Treasured Star. Our colt should be well inspected at Melbourne Premier as I believe he is the only **TORONADO** scheduled in the Rushton Park draft of around 20. The **LOVEYAMADLY/SO YOU THINK** filly looks to have plenty of scope about her and she should be a lovely yearling this time next year. Anticipated to be raced by her Syndicate, this filly looks to have plenty of High Chaparral about her and this mating was designed to get a bit more strength and to test the breed out over distance which has been successfully tried in the past as per her family via Hi World (x High Chaparral)-winner of the GROUP 3 ATC Carbine Club!

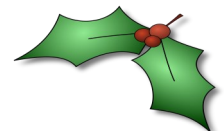

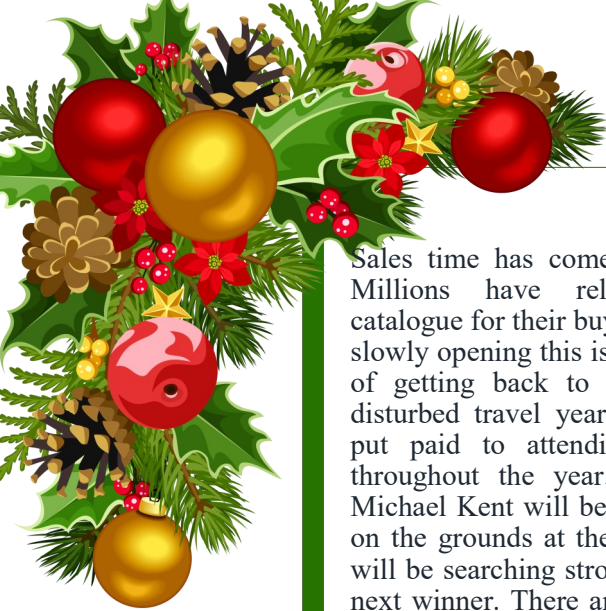
