From the Stable

Our little stable star **I'MLOVIN'YA** was certainly that over the past few months and her short and sharp recent preparation with Mick Price and Michael Kent resulted in her second stakes win, that of the Redelva Stakes in Adelaide where she won in emphatic fashion. The home bred daughter of Capitalist began brilliantly from a low draw and was always up with the leading pack where it was certainly keen with a number of horses vying for the lead. Jockey Zac Spain eventually burrowed through along the rails at the turn to go to the lead and when asked to extend unleashed an impressive sprint, to race away with the Redelva winning convincingly by just on 2 lengths throttling down on the line. Backing up two weeks later in the **GROUP 1** Sangster Stakes and failing, the overall thought was that the two trips were a bit much and although nothing conclusive was found after veterinary testing post the Sangster, the thought was to play safe with her and give her a break for the upcoming season where she will be kept nice and fresh in between runs. She has just completed a lovely 6 week break up at Adrian Park Wangaratta and has just resumed pre training with the Ledgers. She will again be placed to advantage through the upcoming Spring and have her raced well-spaced as she does appear to excel when fresh. Races like the LISTED Wylie Hcp in Adelaide and the LISTED Alinghi Stakes on Caulfield Cup day are realistic options for this filly who has raced at GROUP and LISTED level in every one of her 8 starts to date which have recorded 2 wins and 2 thirds for \$197,220 in stakes. **I'MLOVIN'YA** is currently only one of two fillies for her sire CAPITALIST to have won 2 stakes races (Comrade Rosa being the other) so she is right up there with the best of the fillies that CAPITALIST has produced to date!

Another of our home bred in **LUSCIOUS** is set to resume racing in the weeks ahead and had her first jump out recently at Cranbourne running 4th in a nice first up effort. This daughter of FIGHTING SUN has been sparingly raced to date as she has taken time to grow and mature as is quite common with first foals and she was a filly that suffered this fate. **LUSCIOUS** has only had two runs to date but is seen to appreciate wet tracks and we have timed this prep to coincide with these wetter tracks in mind. She is a lovely filly to do anything with and presents with a great attitude to her racing and being a nice and sound filly, we hope that we can find a win for her this prep and for the Mare Liberty Made who the Syndicate is currently breeding with.

Our problem child **RUSSIAN MINT** continues to frustrate his Syndicate of owners and his first up run whilst satisfactory is still not racing to the ability that he has previously shown in his trackwork and trials. He continually races too keenly and subsequently leaves little in the tank for his final 200 metres and subsequently weakens which is not ideal. He has been given equestrian/beach work in an effort to settle him down more in his races however to date all efforts have produced little. His first up run as mentioned was satisfactory finishing 6th beaten 4.25 lengths at Mornington May 23 where the winner Keane Enuff won by 3 lengths and, who was not disgraced himself in Open 3YO company at Flemington recently so in fairness he is running into some nice types. A setback post Mornington has resulted in a few weeks on the recovery trail for **RUSSIAN MINT** however he is back in full work now down at Denistoun Park Balnarring and would be expected to be back at the

races next month. Let's hope the penny drops and this **RUSSIAN REVOLUTION** gelding can see success at the races very soon!

One filly that we are all keen to see work through from trackwork to the races is our **WRITTEN BY** filly **WRITTEN FOR US** who has been plagued with immaturity issues basically all of the way from breaking until now. A very immature immune system has seen this girl catch just about every bug that presents without having the strength in her system to be able to shake them off and only up until recently we haven't been able to get a handle on her at all. The time

that we have been able to do some serious work with her she has indicated that she looks to be a promising filly with a future and although that she has gone out to the paddock again, we are more than comfortable in knowing that we have a filly to work with next time around however patience will be the key. She is an outstanding physical type with a brain and is amongst one of the favourite fillies amongst stable staff at the Mick Price/Michael Kent stables. This filly will most likely continue to be a wait and see proposition but once her immaturity issues clear which they will I am sure that success will come her way as she is too nice a type for that not to occur!

2023 Yearlings

Our yearlings of 2023 continue to impress with the pre trainers and whilst a couple of these yearlings may take a touch of time to present at the races being out of staying stallions, they are all heading the right way and there have been no issues to be reporting to date on any of them. The first of these staying types is our **TARZINO/FIRST BLOOM** colt purchased for NZ \$70,000 at this years Karaka Premier Yearling sales. He is a lovely raw individual who is a half brother to the **GROUP 3** Hawksbury Guineas winner **EXOBOOM** and more recently the LISTED Hawkes Bay Cup winner in **FIERCE FLIGHT**. **FIRST BLOOM'S** third foal to race in the Peter and Paul Snowden trained **ASVA** is also now a winner at Newcastle so from three foals to have raced, the mare **FIRST BLOOM** has produced 2 Stakes Winners and a recent Maiden winner so there would be high expectations that our **TARZINO** colt could also do the same when it is his turn to race given the mare's success with her progeny to date. Our colt is currently spelling after a recent 6-week pre training stint with the

Ledgers and was accomplished all throughout and has an excellent brain and very keen on the uptake when anything new is shown to him which is always nice to hear!

Another staying type in our **SO YOU THINK/ LOVEYAMADLY** filly is currently in her first stint in pre training since her initial breaking in and is progressing along well. An athletic daughter of **SO YOU THINK**, this filly is an outstanding physical specimen and carries the excellent nature and willingness to learn as all of the previous foals of **Loveyamadly** have shown. She is just starting the transition to becoming a future racehorse and like her **TARZINO** stablemate who did similar, is out on the track doing a lot of trotting and cantering in groups getting used to what is expected in a racing type scenario. She will continue this for the next 4 weeks after which she will have a nice break and will resume pre training again in the Spring with a venture down to Cranbourne likely after that.

The third foal out of LIBERTY MADE in our **MAGNUS/LIBERTY MADE** colt certainly suffers little on the size side and is a lovely correct colt with a great nature and has progressed very well since his breaking in education some time ago now having also accomplished his first stint of pre training without issue and has been spelling for about 3 weeks out at Adrian Park Wangaratta. He will only have about

another 3-4 weeks out before resuming work and may have a look at Cranbourne at some stage next prep if he continues in the manner that he finished off last prep as this guy was faultless in his approach and held an outstanding attitude and temperament for a colt. Things can often change with colt's when Spring comes around, however he has been good to date and has caused no issues in his time with the Ledgers!

Broodmares/Weanlings

Our now weanlings of 2023 are all progressing very well up at Sledmere Stud Scone under the watchful eyes of Stud Manager Royston Murphy and at Rushton Park under the same watchful eyes of David and Kayley Johnson. Whilst plans can obviously change at very short notice we anticipate to be having 4 nice yearlings to be offering at next year's Yearling sales. It will be interesting to see how the King's Legacy progeny are received next year's sales with their first progeny on offer and we look to have two fillies ourselves to be offering in our **KING'S LEGACY/MISS DAMITA** filly and our **KING'S LEGACY/LOVEYAMADLY** filly. Both are lovely correct athletic types, and it is hoped that we can kick these off in nice fashion next year with a good result for their respective breeding Syndicates. The **KING'S LEGACY** progeny sold up to \$165,000 at the recent Gold Coast Weanling sales in May and King's Legacy himself was one of the top first season stallions at that sale.

The same also applies to **RUSSIAN CAMELOT** (a son of Camelot) and how he will be received next year as currently he has been hard to assess given that he has had limited offering at this years weanling sales with none presenting at the Inglis weanling sales and only two at the Gold Coast, however one did manage to make \$100,000 which is encouraging! From reports coming in, the common theme is that they are very immature, big, long legged unattractive individuals with little to like about which is why only a couple presented at this years weanling sales, however our colt is a very correct, attractive individual and is the splitting image of her Mum in Undoubtedly So and she has certainly thrown that attractiveness into her foal. He is a nice colt and I would imagine would be one of the better **RUSSIAN CAMELOT** yearlings that will present at the sales next year so we have plenty of optimism for his breeding Syndicate should he continue to progress physically in the same manner between now and next year!
