Zinnovation

From the Stable

It has certainly been a busy couple of months for our pre trainers/breakers and our Syndicate horses are well on the way with their educations and respective racetrack careers. Our Tarzino stayer **ZINOVATION** kicked off his racing career at Cranbourne March 21 with a respectable 3rd over an unsuitable 1600-metre trip first up and looks to have a nice staying future ahead. **ZINOVATION** has been a relatively straight forward conveyance but is still quite raw and will be a horse that will just continue to improve as he races throughout a campaign and as the distances increase. Cranbourne was a nice starting point, and his first up run was quite good. The race didn't quite pan out for him as expected as he missed the start by 2 lengths from an inside draw and found himself three back along the fence on a tight turning track off a stop and start speed which is not ideal for a big horse like him. Rider Beau Mertens managed to extricate **ZINOVATION** off the rails at the 600-metre mark and from that point made steady ground in the straight and was finding the line strong over the concluding stages. He has pulled up well from that run and next heads to Terang-on-Terang Cup day Sunday April 13 to run in an 1850-metre Maiden which will suit, particularly being on a nice big track with the addition of a step up in trip. **ZINOVATION** is still finding his way and learning his craft but from what we have seen from him appears a genuine type who is nice and sound and very clean winded which are two attributes necessary for a staying horse. He is a horse to follow as he extends out in trip!

As previously mentioned, our pre trainers/breakers in John, Chris and Brad Ledger are certainly currently busy with our Syndicate horses and are doing all the necessary work to see these horses transition down to Cranbourne in the coming

months. One horse that we are very keen to see down at Cranbourne is our Adelaide Magic Million horse of last year in **FORT OF DREAMS**. This colt showed plenty down at Cranbourne when he ventured down late last year only to fall away right at the end when presented to trial. He was on the downward spiral at that point and had lightened off from a condition point of view so there is plenty of upside for this guy. He was matching it very well out on the track with Mick and Michael's better 2YO'S and is looking bigger and stronger this time around. A gorgeous athletic colt by Tassort, **FORT OF DREAMS** comes from a lovely running successful Emirates Park family that includes SANTOS, MELAGRANA, SEBONACK, ADEWIN, MUTAWAAJID, FATOON, FAT AL etc who were all Black type performers in their own right and **FORT OF DREAMS** certainly showed that he too has his fair share of ability from what we have seen to date. He has been in work just on 1 month and would be expected to arrive down at Cranbourne in the next couple of weeks!

One homebred filly that we have been patiently waiting for is **LOVEYAMORE** an outstanding physical type by Toronado out of our Metropolitan winning mare in Bella Amore. Unfortunately, her brain doesn't quite match her outstanding physical appearance, however time will cure that and eventually be her friend. She has had a tendency to do a few immature things out on the track and within the stable however is improving each and every prep and although we have just turned her out for a spell, she was very close to coming down to Cranbourne for a look and see. A patient approach is required for this filly which I am sure will benefit her and the Syndicate as the Toronado breed are known for the exact issues that **LOVEYAMORE** is currently displaying. She finished off her time with the Ledgers on a good note and

heads to the paddock having had a good experience and after this short spell would be considered well on the way (with a bit of anticipated natural mental improvement) with her education and to transition into a proper racehorse. She will only spell for the month of April and commence work again on May 1 which should then see her head down to Cranbourne after only about 4-6 weeks of pre training. It is important that when she heads down to Cranbourne she does so when all of her little immature traits are behind her as Cranbourne is a completely different beast to what she would have experienced at Wangaratta and has a different set of mental challenges ahead for her to experience and overcome.

Our almost forgotten Syndicate filly in **WRITTEN FOR US** pleasingly resumed pre training in March and to date all has gone well in the first month of pre training. This filly has had a rotten start to life having had two surgeries which has required quite a long rehabilitation, however that rehabilitation has now concluded, and she is back going again albeit a nice conservative kind approach is being undertaken ensuring that she ticks all of the necessary

boxes at each stage before an increase in her fitness program is undertaken. **WRITTEN FOR US** is one of the more promising fillies that I have been involved with for some time and showed excellent ability on the track so we hope that she can get back to that type of form. I would like to praise each and every Syndicate member for giving this filly the time required and if we do fail at any point in the future with her, we at least know that we did the right thing by the horse and respected the veterinary advice given all along the way. At this stage it is onwards and upwards and she looks outstanding physically which is normally an excellent sign that the horse is feeling well within herself so stay tuned! Another horse who will be resuming pretraining next week after surgery is **FLAVIUS** who has also shown promise and trialled very well prior to sustaining that injury. **FLAVIUS**, another Syndicate homebred by **MAGNUS** resumes from a 3-month spell and again looks outstanding from a coat and condition point of view. He was excellent in his work at Cranbourne last prep, trialled well and looks to have a nice future ahead. Look out for him as a horse to follow when he eventually heads back down to Cranbourne Mid-May!

Stay Inside Purchase Sydney Classic Sale

One stallion that I was very keen to get involved with at this year's yearling sales was the Golden Slipper winning son of Extreme Choice in **STAY INSIDE** and eventually found the right type at the right price at the recently concluded Sydney Classic sale. The **STAY INSIDE** yearlings averaged \$400,000 at the Gold Coast Magic Millions and accordingly were very hard to purchase. Sydney Classic always presents nice types and realistic prices which is a pleasant change, and we found ourselves purchasing Lot 347 out of the Zoffany mare in

Kansino for \$135,000 which represented outstanding value on the prices that were being achieved from vendors at the Gold Coast. He is a lovely strong robust colt with a running pedigree and stacks up extremely well on quality from those that we saw on the Gold Coast. He has a pedigree that boasts Black type performers across all dams which is something that I look for in prospective yearlings as it demonstrates a family that continues to breed on and with Kansino being a half sister to **INVINCIBLE STAR**, a dual **GROUP** winner and

having run second in the GROUP 1 Coolmore Stud Stakes it gives you the confidence that this family will continue on with its consistency of producing Black type performers. **STAY INSIDE** was an outstanding 2YO and dominate winner of the 2021 Golden Slipper defeating Champion WFA star in Anamoe in the process and had an absolutely electrifying turn of foot. If anyone gets the opportunity of watching his victories in his three race victories, you will see that turn of foot on full display! Our colt has just commenced his breaking in with John Ledger and the team at Wangaratta after a nice 6 week let down from the sale and I look forward to his development over the coming months!

Another colt who has just about completed his breaking in, also with the Ledgers is our **EXCEEDANCE/MISS DAMITA** homebred and pleasingly I can report that he has handled himself very well with no issues. This guy has really bloomed physically particularly over the last 3 months and has really developed into a lovely strong colt with a big hind quarter and currently has a lovely attitude about him. A lot to like about this guy and whilst obviously not a lot is known currently from an ability point of view, John Ledger is very impressed with his physicality and attitude which are two important traits to have heading to the future. He will be expected to head out to Adrian Park next week for a well-earned spell and will commence his first pre training prep in about 6 weeks' time!

Broodmares/Foals

Pleasingly, nothing has changed since December, and it was and continues to be a successful foaling season for our 2 broodmares **LOVEYAMADLY** and **BELLA AMORE** who both presented their respective Syndicates with two outstanding foals. **BELLA AMORE** foaled an outstanding **CAPITALIST** colt who is a three-quarter brother to the dual stakes' winner I'MLOVIN'YA whilst **LOVEYAMADLY** foaled an outstanding **I AM INVINCIBLE** filly who is a half sister to the GROUP 3 winning IMMORTAL LOVE and dual stakes winner I'MLOVIN'YA. Both are quality foals and all going well will be offered for sale over the 2026 yearling sale series which is most exciting for all involved with at this early stage our Capitalist colt is earmarked for the 2026 Magic Millions on the Gold Coast and our I Am Invincible filly is likely for Sydney Easter 2026! They are being reared at one of Australia's famous nurseries in Sledmere Stud and will get every chance in life as they grow and develop throughout 2025!
